Victims rights. Assistance throughout trials and hearings.

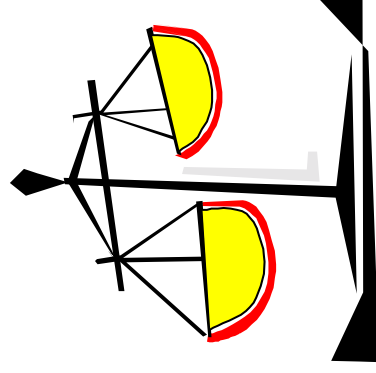
- Assist the Victim in the participation of restorative Justice alternatives where available and applicable.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

- Long-term analyses and assistance with family financial planning changes resulting from crime and assistance with social agencies.
